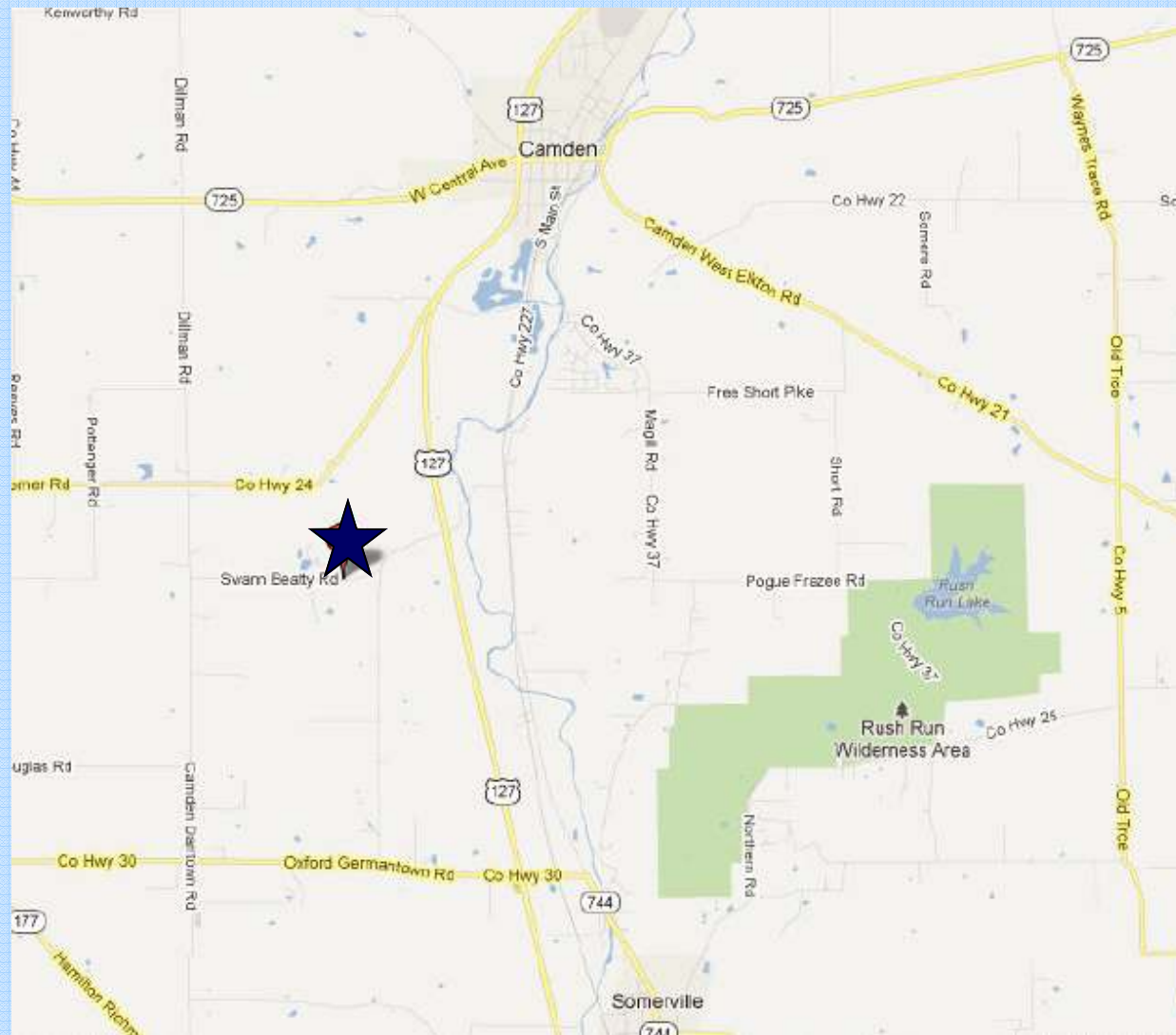

Directions

From the NE (Central Ohio):

Take I-70 Exit #10, towards Eaton/US Rt. 127. After Eaton, continue 8 miles to Camden. Go thru the stoplight at the intersection of St. Rt. 725 then take the first road to the right. - Camden College Corner Rd. Travel approx 2 miles, then take the first left - Camden Darrown Rd. Travel about ½ mile, then take the first left onto Swann Beatty Road. Camp is 0.8 miles down road on the left.

From the East (Dayton area):

From I-75 take St. Rt. 725 west to Miamisburg. Follow Rt. 725 to Camden. At far edge of Camden, at stoplight, turn South (left) onto Rt 127. Turn right onto the first road to the right - Camden College Corner Rd. Travel approx 2 miles, then take first left onto Camden Darrown Rd. Travel about ½ mile, then take the first left onto Swann Beatty Road. Camp is 0.8 miles on the left.

From the South and South East :

On I-75 N, take St Rt. 129 towards Hamilton. In Hamilton, after underpass, turn right onto Rt. 127 North. Go 15 miles and turn left onto Somerville/ Rt. 744 exit (Immediately after the "Entering Preble County" sign). At bottom of hill (where exit tees), turn left onto Oxford-Germantown Rd. Turn right at the next road (Stephen Young Rd.). Continue for about one mile, then turn left at the next road (Swann Beatty Rd.). Camp is 0.2 mile up the hill.

From the Southwest (west Cincinnati area):

From I-275 take Colerain Exit/Rt. 27 North to Oxford. In the center of Oxford, turn right onto Rt. 732 N and continue past Hueston Woods State Park. Just beyond the park entrance and sharp bend in road, continue straight ahead and cross Rt. 177. The road becomes Oxford Germantown Rd. Follow for approx 2 miles, then make the first left onto Camden Darrown Rd. After approx ½ mile, turn right onto Swann Beatty Rd. Camp is 0.8 miles down road on the left.
